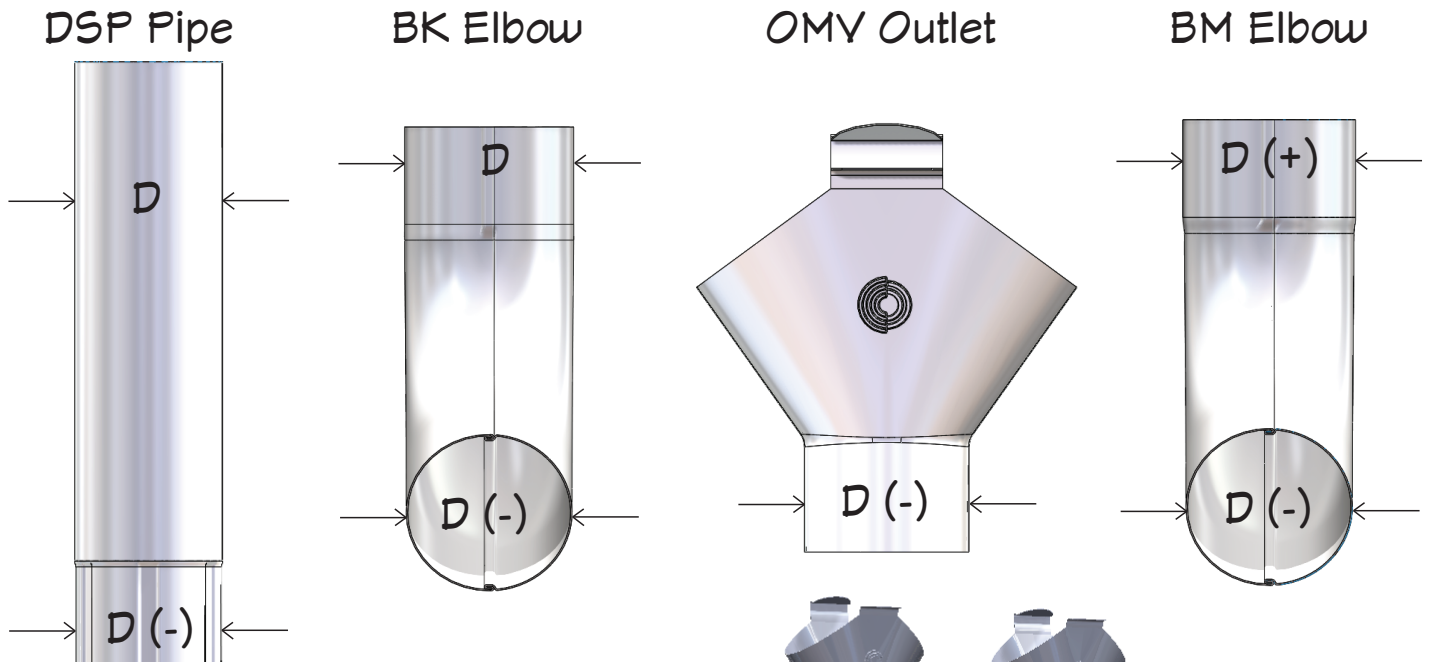


To BK or to BM  
the story of two elbows.

Lindab pipe components slide together forming a mechanical seal. Pipes have a shrunk end to fit into joining pipes, resulting in a smooth finish. Elbows come in two styles identified as BK or BM. The male end of all fittings fit nominal pipe diameter "D" however the top or female end is either nominal diameter as in the BK Elbow or expanded to fit the cut end of a pipe as in the BM Elbow.



Always allow for a BK Elbow to join at the Outlet OMY. Choose a BM Elbow to join the gooseneck pipe to the wall pipe, to utilize cut pipe sections.

Use a BK Elbow when joining directly to another elbow or shrunk end of a downpipe. A BM Elbow is your best choice for most areas as they can join to cut pipes. All other pipe connectors such as SOKN and UTK are a BM style.
